Explanation describing how procurement by competitive means is either not practicable or advantageous to the State: As per federal law Section 302 of the Medicare Modernization Act of 2003 (MMA), CMS requires all Durable Medical Equipment, Prosthetics, Orthotics, and Supplies (DMEPOS) vendors to compete and become Medicare approved contract suppliers. Successful bidders are in good standing with an active Provider Transaction Access Number (PTAN), be accredited by CMS and must have all applicable state licenses for each state it provides services as well as meet all CMS financial standards. Due to the nature of healthcare industry, supplier must also be able to provide all Medicare Part B services and supplies in a timely manner to all HHSC facilities across the State. Pharmerica is single CMS approved vendor able to meet all the above mentioned requirements and is a competitive bid winner from CMS. HHSC is only allowed to contract with CMS contract suppliers. It is imperative that a vendor be familiar with the varying needs of the patients within each HHSC facility. Pharmerica has been servicing HHSC's hospitals for the last 8 years across the state. It is neither practical nor advantageous to the State to expend the time and resources to compete for these services when Pharmerica is an authorized CMS contract supplier and meets all of HHSC's needs for Part B Services.
