

Minimum Qualification Specifications  
for the Class:HOSPITAL ROOM SERVICE ATTENDANT  
BC-03; BU:01

Education: High school diploma or equivalent

Skills: English fluency.

Specialized Experience:

One (1) year of food service experience in a healthcare or hospitality setting serving customers and preparing table settings. Of the one (1) year of food service experience, six months of experience must have been in assisting with the preparation of special diets.

Physical Requirements:

Applicants must be physically able to perform, efficiently and effectively, the essential duties of the position which typically require the ability to read without strain printed material the size of typewritten characters, glasses permitted, and the ability to hear the conversational voice, with or without a hearing aid, or the ability to compensate satisfactorily. Disabilities in these or other areas will not automatically result in disqualification. Those applicants who demonstrate that they are capable of performing the essential functions of the position will not be disqualified under this section.

Applicants must demonstrate exceptional personal hygiene and grooming.

Any condition, which would cause applicants to be a hazard to themselves or others, is cause for disqualification.

Mental/Emotional Requirements:

All applicants must possess emotional and mental stability appropriate to the job duties and responsibilities and working conditions.
