Requirement	Comments/Related Job Duty
Can Distinguish Smells	Frequent
Can Distinguish Tastes	Occasional
Can Hear: Normal Tones	Frequent—able to hear overhead PA announcements; pager; alarm; radio calls; respond to garbled radio/walkie talkie; etc.
Soft Tones	Frequent
Can Distinguish Temperatures By Touch/Proximity	Frequent
Eyesight: Normal/Corrected	Frequent—conduct surveillance on suspects; identify persons/suspect by color of clothing, hair and skin color; identify color of vehicles
Close Eye Work (reading small figures)	Frequent—read reports

Mental

Requirement	Comments/Related Job Duty
Can Read, Speak and Write (What language/s)	English – in order to communicate and complete assignments; read reports; write citations; etc.
Is Oriented with Reality	Necessary
Can control Emotions (temper, etc.)	Necessary
Has Positive Attitude toward the ill, the Handicapped and the Elderly	Necessary
Can Remember/Recall	Necessary
Able to Work with Controlled Substances (drugs)	N/A
Can Handle Stress	Necessary as it relates to both physical and mental
