KVMH is in need of one Locum Tenens Physician for a short term duration from August 1, 2005 to January 31, 2006, to provide medical radiology services for patients in the community the hospital serves. KVMH has been actively seeking to secure medical radiology services since Dr. Spielman announced his intention not to renew his contract on the 16th of May 2005. We have been unsuccessful in our recruitment attempts for an onsite physician. Dr. Spielman has made himself available on a part time (30 hours per week) basis to perform these vital services. The lack of on site services of a medical radiologist at KVMH poses a threat to the health and safety of our patients. Furthermore, without such a physician KVMH would be severely restricted in its emergency department services adversely affecting the West Side of Kauai.
