Nature of the Emergency: A situation of an unusual and compelling urgency creates a threat to life, public health, welfare, and safety by reasons of the Hilo Medical Centers potential inability to provide immediate medical care to the community of East Hawaii Region. Without the goods and services identified within Exhibit A (attached) the health and safety of any person not receiving adequate emergency care is seriously threatened.	
Vendor: Vendors are listed under Exhibit A - attached	Amount: <i>NTE</i> \$400,000.00 <i>TOTAL ALL VENDORS</i>
Description of goods services or construction to be purchased: Much of the equipment and supplies used in the running of an acute care hospital are specialty items requested by the practitioners due to the particular expertise of the practitioner, training of the practitioner and based on the needs of a particular type of patient. It is not possible to anticipate in advance and "stock" these items, which would be too expensive to keep on hand. The standard of practice in running an acute care hospital requires that various specialty vendors establish relationships with the hospital in advance and be available to provide the specific item needed on very short notice once a patient is identified with a particular need. The following medical categories are considered areas critical to human life and welfare and require that certain specialty goods and services be made immediately available as requested within the discretion and judgment of the medical staff for emergency utilization. a) Ortho, b) Vascular, c) Urology, d) Ear, Nose & Throat, e) Ophthal, f) OB/GYN, g) Anesthesia	
Reason for Vendor Selection: The list of vendors are selected based on availability in Hilo, willingness to assist the physician in selecting the precise item that will meet the needs of a specific patient, and having the specific brand name products that are needed. Physician training, human life risk mitigation & experience of the vendors in supplying these items in a manner that meets the needs of the patients was considered in their selection.
