Amount: NTE \$400,000.00 TOTAL Vendor: Vendors are listed under Exhibit A - attached Description of goods services or construction to be purchased: Much of the equipment and supplies used in the running of an acute care hospital are specialty items requested by the practitioners due to the particular expertise of the practitioner, training of the practitioner and based on the needs of a particular type of patient. It is not possible to anticipate in advance and "stock" these items, which would be too expensive to keep on hand. The standard of practice in running an acute care hospital requires that various specialty vendors establish relationships with the hospital in advance and be available to provide the specific item needed on very short notice once a patient is identified with a particular need.
