
Description of goods, services, or construction to be purchased:
One-on-one security guard services on an "as needed" basis to ensure the safety of Hilo Medical Center's patients, employees and visitors.

Reason for Vendor Selection:
Wackenhut currently provides services to Hilo Medical Center. An earlier SPO Form 2 resulted in a contract HHSC FY06-114 through December 31, 2005. A new purchase request dated October 6, 2005, was submitted for processing, however, the action is still in process and has not yet been completed. Through this SPO Form 2, we are asking for permission to use Wackenhut's services until a new contract for services from January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2007, is completed through the RFP process. This would provide continuous service, thereby mitigating the IMMEDIATE THREAT OF HARM TO PUBLIC HEALTH.
