Sorry again.

I spoke with Warren and Debra on this. The feeling was that no long term a/c maintenance should be done via the emergency procurement. It seems that Hilo wanted to do a solicitation a while back but it got grouped with other HHSC's hospitial facilities on different Islands. This being the case, the solicitation has not been able to be issued. My feeling was that a single bid for all islands for all facilities would be a bear to issue and manage. But if this is the direction that HHSC wants to pursue, then an exemption should be done for Hilo to allow the existing contract to continue to provide the maintenance until a new contractor is on board via the a new contract. But the justification would have to say why Hilo did not issue a separate bid and why HHSC's decision to group all the facilities is advantegeous to delay the issuance of Hilo contract. The emergency procurement method should only be used for the Immediate need (to repair).
