Nature of the Emergency: West Kauai Medical Clinic requires the purchasing of orthopedic implants from DePuy Co. We are in the process of completing our contract with them following Chapter 103 and 103D. However, due to the complexities of the contracting process, medical issues that had to be resolved, and detailed product information that was required, the tax clearance certificate expired in May. Medically necessary surgeries are scheduled during the month of July. We are requesting an emergency exemption until the tax clearance certificate is obtained and presented to WKMC and the contract is executed—all of which should happen by July 31, 2006.

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Description of goods, services, or construction to be purchased:
Implants and supplies for joint cases.

Reason for Vendor Selection: Dr. Rick Goding, Orthopedist at WKMC, has specifically requested the products from DePuy as being medically necessary for the surgeries he is conducting during the month of July. These surgeries are difficult and problematic to the patients to reschedule. The products are necessary and required to support the quality of life decisions for patient quality and patient care.
