HHSC desires to issue a formal RFP for the pathology services provided under this agreement but must wait until such time that the HHSC EMR and ICD-10 implementations are completed. Note: HHSC did issue a competitive solicitation for these services in 2012, which was subsequently suspended when all parties, including Offerors, agreed that HHSC was unable to move forward due to the burden of EMR and ICD-10 implementations. HHSC lacks the required staffing to accommodate implementation of the EMR and ICD-10 projects, and until these implementations are completed HHSC will not have adequate resources to undertake the complex technical process of migrating from one laboratory information system to another if a new pathology and lab services provider is selected. HHSC, currently subject to the procurement code, and in conformance with §103DHRS, has been extending the contract's period of performance in 180-day increments since June, 2011. The on-going method of 180 day extensions is neither advantageous nor practical, and HHSC desires to extend the agreement for a period of time greater than 180 days. A long term extension of the Time of Performance is currently prohibited by§103D and admin rules.
