8. EXPLANATION DESCRIBING HOW PROCUREMENT BY COMPETITIVE MEANS IS EITHER NOT PRACTICABLE OR ADVANTAGEOUS TO THE STATE:

Exemption from HRS Chapter 103D to procure licensing for entertainment and copyright infringement services for the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation (HHSC) system. This procurement is necessary to ensure HHSC remains compliant with applicable federal copyright laws and licensing requirements and to mitigate the risk of copyright infringement claims, penalties, and legal liability, particularly in light of the escalating threat of legal review and enforcement actions by Global Music Rights (GMR). Due to the exclusive rights held by copyright owners and their authorized licensing organizations, competitive procurement is not practicable.

9. DETAILS OF THE PROCESS OR PROCEDURES TO BE FOLLOWED IN SELECTING THE VENDOR TO ENSURE MAXIMUM FAIR AND OPEN COMPETITION AS PRACTICABLE:

HHSC will procure the required blanket public performance license from the Motion Picture Licensing Corporation, the authorized licensing organization that provides licensing for the public performance of copyrighted motion pictures and television programming. The agency will verify that the license meets HHSC's operational requirements, provides the necessary copyright coverage for patient and public areas throughout the system, and that the pricing and terms are fair and reasonable prior to execution of the agreement.

10. A DESCRIPTION OF THE AGENCY'S INTERNAL CONTROLS AND APPROVAL REQUIREMENTS FOR THE EXEMPTED PROCUREMENT:

The procurement will be subject to HHSC's established internal procurement controls, including program review to confirm the operational need for systemwide copyright licensing, fiscal review to verify funding availability, and procurement review to ensure compliance with HRS Chapter 103D and applicable HHSC procurement policies. Final approval will be obtained through the appropriate HHSC approving authority prior to execution of the agreement.
