The current project manager, Daryl Chow, has been the key architect of the current project design and use and has the knowledge and experience gained over 5 ½ years working on the Kronos project. The current design of the overall structure of the product and the overall processes in place are the result of working directly with HHSC staff, vendors and senior management of our pilot facility, as well as with the Steering Committee of the project for HHSC. The vendor's background includes education, experience and knowledge of payroll, human resources, auditing and finance in a healthcare environment.
