8. Explanation describing how procurement by competitive means is either not practicable nor advantageous to the State:

Mrs Takayama, has extensive experience and knowledge working in and with the Hawaii State Legislature. She is well trusted and well respected by the HHSC Board of Directors for her sound and sage advice on a variety of strategic and oftentimes very sensitive matters and that kind of trust-relationship is not easily or quickly replaced. Mrs. Takayama personally knows and has worked with on many occasions a very large number of Legislators at the State Capitol. She has been associated with HHSC for over 6 years in a consultant / advisor / lobbyist capacity. Because of the many sensitive, political and sometimes controversial issues and actions that a Lobbyist must deal with on a regular basis, it is not only impractical but also inappropriate to solicit contractor bids to become a "lobbyist" for an organization and therefore an exempt procurement for a Lobbyist is the only viable option.
