Pursuant to §103D-102(b)(4), HRS, and Chapter 3-120, HAR, the Department requests a procurement exemption to purchase the following:

3. Description of goods, services or construction: To obtain consultant services to further research, develop, and implement cardiovascular programs at the Hilo Medical Center.

8. Explanation describing how procurement by competitive means is either not practicable nor advantageous to the State: HHSC has embarked upon a program to establish a state-of-the-art interventional heart and vascular program to support two of its facilities: Maui Memorial and Hilo Medical Centers. Consultants were asked, in response to a competitive RFQ issued by the Maui Memorial Medical Center (MMMC), to develop and submit a Preliminary Assessment designed to evaluate the opportunities for cardiovascular service improvement (invasive and noninvasive cardiac and vascular services, electrophysiology, cardiac rehabilitation, cardiovascular surgery) in Maui and Hilo. Only one Company, John Goodman & Associates Inc. was found to possess the necessary background and expertise to provide the proper guidance to define HHSC's Cardiovascular needs. Because of the different cardiovascular objectives (invasive vs. noninvasive) between the Maui and Hilo Medical Centers, a separate Assessment is required for the Hilo Medical Center. Since the program includes more than one HHSC facility, it is vital that the same Consultant be involved in the identification of needs and requirements of each facility in order to ensure continuity of plans and objectives. Resolicitation of this requirement could be costly, time consuming and could create potential issues involving standardization and interoperability and will most likely result in an award to the same company.			
9. Details of the process or procedures to be followed in selecting the vendor to ensure maximum fair and open competition as practicable: HHSC's need for Consultants for these and other kinds of services will be added to the Notice to Providers for Professional Services published annually in accordance with 103D-303. HHSC will make every endeavor to expand and promote competitive procurements.			
10. A description of the agency's internal controls and approval requirements for the exempted procurement: The Director of Contract Management reviews requests for exemptions for sufficiency prior to submission to the President and CEO for action.


