## **FACT**

IFB No. HHSC FY07-015 issued on 10/31/06 with closing of 11/28/06.

Two proposals were received.

1. GE Healthcare - \$41,447.70 (GE AMX-4+S2000, x-ray portable machine.)

GE's proposal was made IAW specifications presented in the IFB. However, GE made numerous exceptions to HHSC's general conditions outside of the date allowed for exceptions.

2. Hawaii Pacific X-Ray - \$31,500 (Shimadzu Mobile Art Plus.)

Hawaii Pacific X-ray offered the "or equal". However, Hawaii Pacific X-ray did not have the "or equal" reviewed and approved prior to them making an offer as stated in the IFB.

Technical Representative was asked to review both proposals and it was determined that GE Healthcare was the acceptable machine and the "or equal" was not acceptable.

However, based on the exceptions or offering of the "or equal" brand, which was not acceptable, it was determined to cancel the solicitation which is allowed by the IFB.

Bid package was sent to five (5) prospective bidders and the two listed above were the only ones that responded.
