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Scope of Work JBD Contract Number 2 for electrical/power upgrades

WKMC Electrical Upgrades and Emergency Power Back Up Upgrade

- 1. Consulting and Design/engineering services to Joint Commission accreditation standards and in conformity with all applicable State, local, and federal codes and regulations. Design/Engineering Consulting services to include:
 - Review all feeder lines from transformer to main switch to distribution panels to assure that phasing and grounding throughout the facility is correct and meets applicable regulatory codes;
 - b. Review electrical system for National Electrical Code violations including, but not limited to, in adequate workspace clearance fronting electrical disconnects, distribution panels, and switches;
 - c. Review all circuits in all distribution panels:
 - i. Review labeling of all switches, lights, and outlets;
 - ii. Verify all circuit breakers are working properly;
 - iii. Determine if additional circuits needed or existing circuits should be replaced;
 - iv. Conduct a thermal analysis of all panels.
 - d. Evaluate the transformers located in the mechanical room.
 - e. Evaluate existing building electrical power system, including back up, to determine options for upgrading the power system to meet existing and additional requirements resulting from renovation and new round building extension (hereinafter called, "expansion project"; see schematics on ionathanbailey.com "WKMC" icon).
 - i. Evaluation to strive for energy efficiency and noncarbon based energy solutions to the extent practicable;
 - Evaluation to take into consideration need for additional back up power for existing operations, as well as additional back up power for
 - f. Design all aspects of needed upgrades and additional power and emergency back up energy requirements based on schematics in expansion project;
 - g. Draft scope of work/specifications for electrical work and equipment needed to construct the designed upgrades and emergency back up energy requirements;

- h. Provide construction documents inclusive of specifications, schedules, architectural, electrical, plumbing, and mechanical plans for construction purposes for the electrical/back up power upgrades;
- i. With input from the Owner, contract with the necessary contractors (hereinafter, the "general contractor") to perform the electrical/back up power work. Electrical work contracted hereunder that affects the areas and electrical systems involved in the construction work described in HHSC FY 08-122 (Jonathan Bailey Design (JBD) contract with HHSC/WKMC dated December 6, 2007) may be included in the contract entered into with the general contractor for that project and shall become part of the Guaranteed Maximum Price. The additional electrical upgrade work required for portions of the facility not under construction in HHSC FY 08-122 shall be contracted in a separate contract between the JBD and the general contractor and paid for out of the fees charged by JBD Consultant under this Agreement.
- 2. Once the design has been finalized and the contractor has been selected and retained to perform the electrical/back up power work, the JBD shall perform construction management services for the electrical/back up power upgrades, including the portions not under renovation or new construction in HHSC FY -08-122. At a minimum, and consistent with HHSC FY 08-122 requirements, JBD shall:
- a. perform construction observation services, to include, visiting the job site at appropriate stages of construction to see that the general contractor is performing properly;
- b. hold on-site meetings with the owner, general contractor, and necessary subcontractors, consistent with the schedule outlined in the Architect/Project management services contract between JBD and Owner dated December 6, 2007, HHSC FY 08-122;
- c. process and review general contractor submittals prior to order and installation of materials;
- d. process, respond, document, and track all general contractor clarification request during construction;
 - e. process owner/general contractor change orders as necessary;
 - f. process punch list and issue substantial completion for project close out;
- g. finalize as built drawings on CADD 1 printed set of drawing to Owner and 1 archive disk to Owner.

3. Permitting is not required for this job. All work will be performed, inspected, and documented per the UBC of the County of Kauai.
