- 8. Explanation describing how procurement by competitive means is either not practicable or advantageous to the State: Soarian (the Siemens system HHSC is implementing) only supports the Siemens ePrescription solution as an embedded workflow or embedded system. To have a third party solution would require a medication workflow that would have physicians using two systems and would not allow the importing of home medications into the patient's longitudinal medication list and would not allow physicians to essentially "push the button" for ePrescription once discharge reconciliation is performed. This also would mean the prescription data would manually have to then be entered into Siemens Soarian. This is neither practical nor possible.
- 9. Details of the process or procedures to be followed in selecting the vendor to ensure maximum fair and open competition as practicable: Due to the reasoning outline in #8 above, direct negotiation with Siemens to procure, install, customize, and deployment of ePrescribing will take place. In addition, Soarian is already the system being implemented at HHSC for our new EMR system. ePrescribing directly integrates with the current Soarian system.
