Currently, Round 2 of the required Competitive Bidding Program for Durable Medical Equipment, Prosthetics, Orthotics and Supplies (DMEPOS) is underway. Section 302 of the Medicare Modernization Act of 2003 mandates that all Medicare contract suppliers shall submit bids to furnish Medicare Part B items in order to reduce costs to beneficiaries. Those suppliers not certified by the CMS - DMEPOS program are prohibited from contracting with anyone. Present HHSC vendor, Pharmerica, is a CMS-DMEPOS Medicare Part B certified supplier. As such, CMS-DMEPOS advises that agencies stay with their current supplier until Round 2 bid results are made public in July 2013 when the names of all successful Medicare Part B certified suppliers for Hawaii are announced. At that time, HHSC can elect to issue an RFP for Medicare Part B Services. As the Round 2 bidding process could take up to a year to produce supplier bid results, this is a partial exemption to extend the contract for longer than 180 days. \$15,000 covers one year of contract costs.  9.
