1. <u>Healthcare Intelligence Application/Upgrade</u>: Healthcare Intelligence Applications incorporate the functionality of certain Applications and Third Party Software previously licensed by HHSC that now require a new application to meet HHSC EMR implementation requirements. In addition to the previously licensed applications and Third Party Software, purchase of Healthcare Intelligence application in order to upgrade to the Healthcare Intelligence suite of applications.
