The BU designation of a class and other BU information contained in the compensation plans should be used only as a general guide.

The number indicated the BU designation most commonly used for the positions in the class.

FLSA DESIGNATIONS EXPLANATORY REMARKS

For administrative convenience, we have reviewed the classes in our compensation plans, and based on general application of FLSA guidelines, have coded the classes in the compensation plan to indicate whether positions in the class are exempt (E) or non-exempt (N) from minimum wage and overtime provisions of the Federal Fair Labor Standards Act.

Any employee in a position which is an exception to the class bargaining unit designation, or any employee in a position whose duties are not a true reflection of the concept of the class to which it is allocated, may also be an exception to the FLSA designation for the class. Employees in such positions must therefore be reviewed individually to determine whether they are FLSA exempt.

Additionally, a number of classes do not readily lend themselves to blanket FLSA designations. These classes have been coded 'R' (review). Positions in such classes should be reviewed individually to determine appropriate FLSA status.

The FLSA designation of a class contained in the compensation plans should be used only as a general guide. Regions should refer to the U.S. Department of Labor's web page: <http://www.dol.gov/whd/flsa/> for guidance.

EEOC JOB CATEGORY DEFINITIONS AND EXPLANATORY NOTES

- A. "Officials and Administrators: Occupations in which employees set broad policies, exercise overall responsibility for execution of these policies, or direct individual departments or special phases of the agency's operations, or provide specialized consultation on a regional, district or area basis."

Includes: Only division chiefs and their deputies, chief staff officers (reporting to department head), and chiefs (SR-28/EM-05 and above) of major institutions (e.g., Hospital Administrators, OCCC Superintendent, Young Correctional Facility Superintendent).

- B. "Professionals: Occupations which require specialized and theoretical knowledge which is usually acquired through college training or through work experience and other training which provides comparable knowledge."

Includes: All positions with bargaining unit codes 13, 23, 73, 93, 09, 29, 79 and 99, except computer programmers I-III and land surveyors. Includes positions in the EMCP which do not meet the criteria for A-Officials and Administrators. Does not include positions associated with any other bargaining unit.

- C. "Technicians: Occupations which require a combination of basic scientific or technical knowledge and manual skill which can be obtained through specialized post-secondary school education or through equivalent on-the-job training."

Includes: Positions that reflect specialized practical knowledges and experience such as: computer programmers and operators, surveyors, engineering technicians, draftsmen III and above, licensed practical nurses, photographers, radio operators, technical illustrators, medical technicians, dental technicians, assessors, wildlife management assistants III and above, etc.

1. Trades-type "technicians" are distinguished from skilled crafts workers in that they perform research related activities rather than trades maintenance and repair. For example: electronic technicians, physical science technicians and agricultural research technicians.
2. Inspection-type positions in this category are distinguished from:
 - a. protective service workers in that they are not engaged in direct protection from physical forces;
 - b. professional workers in that they typically do not require education characterized by a college degree; and

- c. skilled craft workers in that they perform inspectional tasks requiring knowledges and enforcement of applicable regulatory codes and they do not actually perform trades maintenance and repair work although trades knowledge may be required.
- 3. Lower level para-professional aide type classes which do not require special training and/or experience are not includable in this category. For example: PMA I and II, and Draftsman I..
- D. "Protective Service Workers: Occupations in which workers are entrusted with public safety, security and protection from destructive forces."

Includes: Positions concerned with direct protection from physical forces (people, things, etc.) such as: patrolmen, guards, special services deputies, correctional officers, marshals, harbor patrol officers, Forest Rangers, Conservation and Resource Enforcement Officers, etc., (excludes professional).

- E. "Para-professionals: Occupations in which workers perform some of the duties of a professional or technician in a supportive role, which usually require less formal training and/or experience normally required for professional or technical status. Such positions may fall within an identified pattern of staff development and promotion under a 'New Careers' concept."

Includes: laboratory assistants, library assistants, medical aides, child support workers, welfare service aides, recreation assistants, homemaker aides, home health aides and kindred workers.

Some positions in this category perform clerical work. They are distinguished from specialized clerical classes in that they typically:

- 1. support a technical or professional occupation;
 - 2. work deals with providing service to the public rather than internal processing of documents; and
 - 3. are found in a career ladder series.
- F. "Office and Clerical: Occupations in which workers are responsible for internal and external communication, recording and retrieval of data and/or information and other paper work required in an office."

This category includes clerical based, white collar supervisory and managerial classes. Positions are located in office settings and involved in support of internal operations of the agency or the State.

Includes: bookkeepers, messengers, office machine operators, clerk typists, stenographers, court transcribers, hearings reporters, statistical clerks, dispatchers, payroll clerks, office managers, and also specialized clerical classes such as Personnel Clerks and Technicians.

- G. "Skilled Craft Workers: Occupations in which workers perform jobs which require special manual skill and through and comprehensive knowledge of the processes involved in the work which is acquired through on-the-job training and experience or through apprenticeship or other formal training programs."

This category includes workers in recognized trades and their supervisors (note: for EEOC, Cooks and Heavy Equipment Operators belong in this category). Positions are in classes which are usually priced at WB-09 and above. Truck drivers and trades helpers do not belong in this category.

Includes: trades based superintendents, (F1-3, GF—but not EM), mechanics and repairmen, electricians, heavy equipment operators, stationary engineers, carpenters, compositors and typesetters and kindred workers.

- H. "Service/Maintenance: Occupations in which workers perform duties which result in or contribute to the comfort, convenience, hygiene or safety of the general public or which contribute to the upkeep and care of buildings, facilities or grounds of public property. Workers in this group may operate machinery."

This category also includes all blue collar workers and their supervisors who do not qualify as "skilled craft workers."

Includes: chauffeurs, laundry and dry cleaning operators, truck drivers, bus drivers, garage laborers, custodial personnel, gardeners and groundskeepers, power mower operators, refuse collectors, laborers, etc.
