This piece has a pressure activated safety valve (PASV) located in the hub of catheter. This valve remains closed unless being used for infusion or aspiration. Valves reduces the risk of occlusion, reduces blood backflow into catheter. This piece requires a saline flush.
Polyurethane material is less likely to kink. piece designed and radiopacity along with one centimeter markers allows excellent visualization under fluoroscopy resulting in accurate placement. Markers help to customize the trim cath length for pt.
This is the only device our physicians will use due to its unique safety features + this is the only source.
